Examine Yourself. Then, Judge. Love Always.

"For it is time for judgment to begin at the household of God; and if it begins with us, what will be the outcome for those who do not obey the gospel of God?" (1 Peter 4:17)

"Examine yourselves to see whether you are in the faith; test yourselves. Do you not realize that Christ Jesus is in you—unless, of course, you fail the test?" (2 Corinthians 13:5)

"<u>Do not merely listen to the word</u>, and so deceive yourselves. <u>Do what it says.</u>" (James1:22)

"Not everyone who says to me (Jesus), 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only he who does the will of my Father who is in heaven." (Matthew 7:21)

Jesus said, "You are my friends if you do what I command. (John 15:14)

First: Examine Yourself. "Do You Love & Obey Jesus?" Ask 2 Questions.

1. "Are you <u>regularly being a witness of Jesus</u>, sharing His story in your life, telling others of being His transformed new creation?" Yes or No?

"And we, who with unveiled faces all reflect the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his likeness with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit." (2 Corinthians 3:18)

2. "Are you <u>regularly sharing the life-saving and life-giving gospel of Jesus</u> with others?" (Matthew 28:19) Yes or No?

Then: Judge. Obey & Warn with GOD's Word & His Agape Love Always.

"For what have I to do with judging outsiders? <u>Is it not those inside the church that you are to judge?</u>" (1 Corinthians 5:12)

"Whoever does not love me (Jesus) does not keep my words. And the word that you hear is not mine but the Father's who sent me." (John 14:24)

"The spiritual person judges all things, but is himself to be judged by no one." (1 Corinthians 2:15)

"We know that we have come to know him (Jesus) if we obey his commands. The man who says, 'I know him,' but does not do what he commands is a liar, and the truth is not in him." (1 John 2:3-4)

"He (the Lord) is patient with you, <u>not wanting anyone to perish, but</u> <u>everyone to come to repentance."</u> (2 Peter 3:9)
