(CCC 969) ***"... the Blessed Virgin (Mary) is Mediatrix."***

Jesus* said, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me (Jesus*)." (John 14:6)

"But if it is by grace, it is no longer on the basis of works; otherwise grace would no longer be grace." (Romans 11:6)

(CCC 969) **“... she (Mary) ... by her manifold intercession continues to bring us (Catholics) the gifts of eternal salvation ... ”**

(CCC 1262) **“Baptism ... the two principal effects are purification from sins and new birth in the Holy Spirit.”**

(CCC 1277) **“Baptism ... is necessary for salvation, as is the (Catholic) Church herself, which we (Catholics) enter by Baptism.”**

“Simon Peter answered him (Jesus*), ... you are the Holy One of God.” (John 6:68-69)

(CCC 2677) **“Holy Mary, Mother of God: ... the All-Holy One.”**

Jesus* said, “Woe to you (religious leaders) ... hypocrites! You shut the door of the kingdom of heaven in people’s faces. You yourselves do not enter, nor will you let those enter who are trying to.” (Matthew 23:13)
