

## **Examine Yourself. Then, Judge. Love Always.**

**"For it is time for judgment to begin at the household of God; and if it begins with us, what will be the outcome for those who do not obey the gospel of God?"** (1 Peter 4:17)

**"Examine yourselves to see whether you are in the faith; test yourselves. Do you not realize that Christ Jesus is in you—unless, of course, you fail the test?"** (2 Corinthians 13:5)

**"Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says."** (James 1:22)

**"Not everyone who says to me (Jesus), 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only he who does the will of my Father who is in heaven."** (Matthew 7:21)

Jesus said, **"You are my friends if you do what I command."** (John 15:14)

**First: Examine Yourself. "Do You Love & Obey Jesus?" Ask 2 Questions.**

1. **"Are you regularly being a witness of Jesus, sharing His story in your life, telling others of being His transformed new creation?"** Yes or No?

**"And we, who with unveiled faces all reflect the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his likeness with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit."** (2 Corinthians 3:18)

2. **"Are you regularly sharing the life-saving and life-giving gospel of Jesus with others?"** (Matthew 28:19) Yes or No?

**Then: Judge. Obey & Warn with GOD's Word & His Agape Love Always.**

**"For what have I to do with judging outsiders? Is it not those inside the church that you are to judge?"** (1 Corinthians 5:12)

**"Whoever does not love me (Jesus) does not keep my words. And the word that you hear is not mine but the Father's who sent me."** (John 14:24)

**"The spiritual person judges all things, but is himself to be judged by no one."** (1 Corinthians 2:15)

**"We know that we have come to know him (Jesus) if we obey his commands. The man who says, 'I know him,' but does not do what he commands is a liar, and the truth is not in him."** (1 John 2:3-4)

**"He (the Lord) is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance."** (2 Peter 3:9)

**Trust & Obey JESUS, or ... Repent for Your Obedience or Salvation.**
